Sports Premium Report 2017 – 18

Grestone Academy's indicative Sports Premium funding for the year 2017 – 18 is £16,000 plus £10 per pupil.

This money is allocated to the continued development of PE and Sport throughout the academy by building on the success of last year when the academy achieved the School Games Award (bronze). During 2017/18 the academy aims to meet the criteria to achieve the School Games Award (silver).

Funding an external consultant who will:

- Support an NQT to develop the skills to become PE curriculum leader across the academy
- Support the academy in developing increased competitive sporting opportunities for pupils through the School Games initiative, leading to the academy achieving a School Games Award (silver).
- Support the academy in implementing the “change for life” initiative in order to get the least active pupils active.
- Support the academy in developing a sports leaders programme at the academy

The academy will also fund a trainee teacher to support the delivery of PE across the academy that will, during the first year of the course there will be a focus on supporting and developing PE and implementing the “change for life” initiative. During the second year of the course the trainee undertakes the PGCE. The trainee has a degree in Sports and Exercise Science. The trainee will develop capacity within the academy ensuring sustainability.

- Support the development of increased competitive sporting opportunities
- Support the continued development of active lunchtimes
- Support the continued development of extra-curricular sporting opportunities
- Support the development of a sports leaders programme within the academy

The expected outcomes of these initiatives are:

- To further improve the quality of PE across the academy
- Provide increased opportunities for pupils to experience a variety of sports enabling them to develop long term active lifestyles
- Provide opportunities to identify talented pupils and signpost them to further activities

- To get the least active pupils active
